

Glossary

This glossary contains the items of vocabulary used in *Nuevo Epañol en marcha 1*, Student's Book, together with their English translations in the context in which they are used here. Bear in mind the endings: *acogedor/a* means that the feminine ending *a* is added onto the masculine form while *abandonado/-a* means that the feminine ending *a* replaces the masculine one. The masculine and feminine articles of nouns are given in brackets: (el), (la). The numbers in brackets indicate the first unit where the word or phrase appears; the part after the numbers shows the section of the unit –A, B, C, D or Autoevaluación (Self-assessment)– or the Anexo. Verbs, once students are familiar with the forms, are shown in the infinitive.
